Churchyard

Our closed Churchyard has been maintained regularly by the Parish Council.

The grass is cut throughout the growing season, with monitoring of the trees, the cherry tree where a decayed branch had been lopped appears to be growing well.

The Topple testing for loose gravestones carried out regularly.

An enormous amount of brambles and Ivy have been cleared near West door of the Church and alongside the school path side of the churchyard, this had been a point of concern to passers-by. Our grateful thanks go to the person employed by the PC who has spent time and effort, this last year in clearing and tidying in what was quite a task. The hedges front, side and back of the church have been trimmed according to growth and allowing for bird nesting activities.

PCC and PC meet regularly throughout the year, to monitor the Churchyard.

Mission

In early 2023 with Interregnum continued following Brin Singleton's retirement in October 2022. With the assistance of the Benefice's Lay Elder's, visiting clergy and the Arch Deacon we were able to continue with services, Mothering Sunday, Easter.
